The accommodation will be organized at **School Campus: Colegiul Tehnic nr.2, street: Victoriei number 142.**

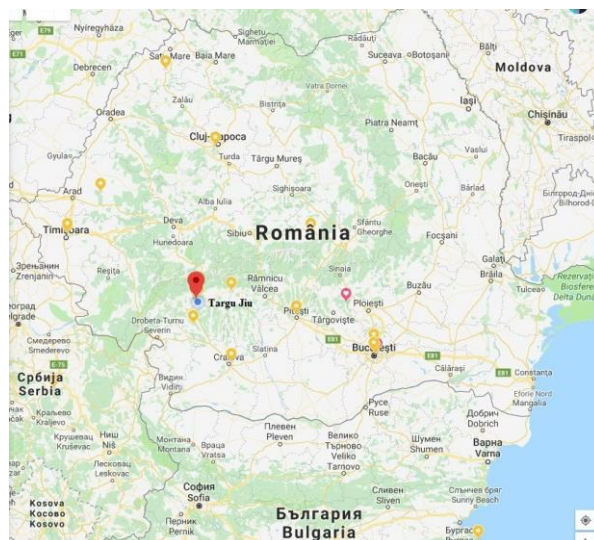
VI. Expected weather

In that period of the year the temperatures during the day are normally 15-30°C and 10-15°C during the night.

VII. Visa requirements

EU citizens only require their national identity papers to travel to Romania. Citizens from most other countries will need a valid passport and visa. Anti COVID regulations must be observed.

VIII. Format and Schedule of the competitions



The competition will be held in individual and team standings for each type of program in all categories (youth and adults).

Team composition:

M14, M16, W14, W16 – team consists of up to five competitors;

M19, M21, M40, M50, M60, M70, W19, W21, W35, W50 - team consists of up to three competitors.

Categories:

M14, M16, M19, M21, M40, M50, M60, M70, W14, W16, W19, W21, W35, W50.

If the category has less than three participants, the organizers reserve the right to transfer participants to the next category.

The competitions are open for all approved male and female categories. They will be awarded separately. Every participating country can take part with unlimited number of entrants in any category individual standings
